

Water activities

Right out in the ocean...

Most islands are blessed with wonderful lagoons where a broad range of water activities is available. Activity providers offer visitors their professional services and will share their love of the sea in order to guide you on a discovery of rich seabeds and natural water environments.

Underwater diving, diving-suit walks, and the Aquascope - a semi-submersible watercraft

Tahiti and her Islands offer some of the most beautiful diving destinations in the world. The fairy-like world of the coral reefs is accessible with or without tanks throughout the year, giving you clear visibility of up to 30 meters.

Excursions by glass-bottomed boat or canoe

Discover the underwater world, picnic on a motu (small island), feed the rays, visit the lagoon sharks. These are just some of the magical experiences available between sea and sky.

Funboarding, surfing, kite surfing, windsurfing, and water skiing

The surfing spots on Tahiti, Moorea and Huahine are among the world's best. The east coast of Tahiti and more specifically the Mahina district are ideally suited to windsurfing. The water sports centers in the Society Islands, often located at the large hotels, provide water sports activities as well as courses for all levels, beginners to advanced.

Parasailing

You can fly over the reefs in optimal safety: exceptional views guaranteed.

Canoe, kayak, outrigger canoe (va'a) and jet ski hire

Whether for the sport or just for a quiet trip around the lagoon, here is yet another way to discover the islands - from the sea.

Sailboats / Charters

Companies hiring out mono-hull sailboats or catamarans are based in Tahiti, Moorea, and especially in the Leeward Islands.

They provide a choice of hire with or without skipper or hostess or the weekend, a few days or a week.

Big game fishing

This sport is widely practiced in the Society Islands where big game fishermen can hire boats by the day and track marlins, mahimahi or swordfish.
