



# AIR TAHITI SCHEDULE

Air Tahiti's extensive schedule comprises up to 200 flights per week (number of departures from Tahiti), to 41 islands, performed with a fleet of turboprops: 4 ATR42 (48 seats) and 5 ATR72 (66 seats). ## Air Tahiti follows the two IATA seasons:

Summer schedule from April 1st to October 31st.  
Winter schedule from November 1st to March 31st.

Air Tahiti can thus take into account the international flight schedules, which follow this same IATA season pattern. The schedule is published and distributed approximately one month before its start date. Flights displayed in the reservation systems for dates that are well after the current schedule are subject to change, but most of the dates booked in anticipation remain valid. The following information is a "must know" for travel professionals, and will give guidance on how to build roundtrips between Tahiti and the various islands that possess international hotels.

**PPTHUH/HUHPPT/PPTRFP/RFPPT/PPTBOB/BOBPPT:** several times a day (up to 9 flights for PPTBOB), with, as a minimum pattern: one early morning flight, one mid-morning, and one late afternoon.

**MOZBOB:** Three times daily, most of them around 10:AM.

**BOBMOZ:** Daily, mid-morning.

**MOZHUH, HUHMOZ:** Daily, late morning.

**HUHBOB/BOBHUH:** Daily with HUHBOB early and late morning.

**MOZRFP:** Monday/Wednesday/Friday and Sunday late morning.

Otherwise you can easily travel MOZPPT (using one of the numerous frequencies of Air Moorea) +  
**PPTRFP:** there is no RFPPT but the combinations RFPPT/PPTMOZ are easy.

**RFPBOB:** Operates on days 1/2/3/5/6/7 and is daily in high season.

**BOBRFP:** Operates on days 1/3/5/7 and day 6 in high season.

**HUHRFP/RFPHUH:** daily except for RFPHUH which does not operate on sundays.

**PPTMAU/MAUPPT:** Days 2/5/7 low season Tuesday/Friday/Sunday, and 1/2/3/5/7 high season.

**PPTRGI/RGIPPT:** 20 flights a week. Several daily flights, with some days the possibility of a day-tour. One flight only on Thursday (low season) and 2 flights in high season.

**PPTXMH/XMHPPT:** Daily. On Monday, you need to transfer (aircraft change) in RGI.

**RGIXMH/XMHRGI:** Monday/Wednesday/Friday/Sunday, and as for XMHRGI, Wednesday/Saturday/Sunday.

**PPTTIH/TIHPPT:** One to two daily, except Thursday. On Thursday, TIHPPT operates all year while PPTTIH is in high season only.

**RGITIH:** Monday/Wednesday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday.

**TIHRGI:** Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday/Friday/Saturday.

**PPTFAV/FAVPPT:** Daily. On Tuesday, transfer in RGI except in high season when an additional direct flight is scheduled.

**RGIFAV:** Tuesday/Friday.

**FAVRGI:** Monday.  
**TIHXMH/XMHTIH:** Wednesday (with aircraft change in RGI)/Saturday, and as for **XMHTIH**, Monday/Friday.



## Go directly from the Leeward Islands to the Tuamotu

All the possibilities addressed in this paragraph relate to segments linking BOB and (RGI or TIH or XMH or FAV). The latest addition to the schedule are two Bora Bora-Fakarava flights on Tuesdays and Fridays which avoid a stop over in Tahiti. All the segments below labeled "with transfer" include a short connection at an intermediate point, smaller than the normal MCT (Minimum Connecting Time), and those "special connections" are guaranteed by Air Tahiti, so there should be no problem in building them in the PNR.

**Monday:** BOBRGI, BOBXMH, direct flights, and BOBTIH transfer in RGI.  
**Tuesday:** BOBRGI, BOBFAV, direct flights.  
**Wednesday:** BOBRGI, BOBTIH, direct flights, and BOBXMH transfer in RGI.  
**Thursday:** BOBRGI, BOBTIH, direct flights.  
**Friday:** BOBRGI, BOBXMH, direct flights, BOBFAV transfer in RGI, and BOBTIH transfer in RGI excepted in high season where a direct flight is added.  
**Saturday:** BOBRGI in August only.  
**Sunday:** BOBRGI, BOBTIH, direct flights, and BOBXMH transfer in RGI.  
**Monday:** XMHBOB, TIHBOB, direct flights, and RGIBOB transfer in TIH.  
**Friday:** XMHBOB, TIHBOB, direct flights, and RGIBOB transfer in TIH.

## Go directly from the Tuamotu to the Leeward Islands

**Friday:** TIHRFP and XMHRFP via TIH.

## Marquesas

**Monday:** PPT-NHV-PPT.  
**Tuesday:** PPT-NHV-AUQ-NHV-PPT.  
**Wednesday:** PPT-NHV-PPT.  
**Thursday:** PPT-NHV-PPT.  
**Friday:** PPT-AUQ-NHV-PPT.  
**Saturday:** PPT-RGI-NHV-PPT.  
**Sunday:** PPT-AUQ-PPT and PPT-NHV-PPT.  
These ATR flights connect in NHV with a Twin-Otter which serves the smaller Marquesas islands of Ua Pou and Ua Huka. On Saturdays, RGINHV trip available by flight VT850, then possible connection to AUQ by Twin Otter. This option can be used within the Pass Bora-Tuamotu + Marquesas extension.
